In 2023, the American Pharmacists Association (APhA) and the American Society of Health-System Pharmacists (ASHP), in collaboration with other pharmacy organizations, established a Pharmacy Workforce Suicide Awareness Day on September 20 to expand public awareness of the increased risk of suicide within our profession. This aligns with many pharmacy organizations' related policies to expand public awareness of this serious issue and to advocate for pharmacists, student pharmacists, pharmacy residents, and pharmacy technicians by providing resources to mitigate mental health and well-being issues that may lead to thoughts of suicide. Statistics from the National Alliance on Mental Illness*:

- 1 in 20 U.S. adults (5%) have serious thoughts of suicide each year.
- About 1 person dies by suicide in the U.S. every 11 minutes.
- 79% of all people who die by suicide in the U.S. are male.
- Although more women than men attempt suicide, men are 4x more likely to die by suicide.
- In the U.S., suicide is the 2nd leading cause of death among people ages 10-14 and among people ages 15-24, and the 11th leading cause of death overall.

Posting Guidance:

- **Timing** share leading up to Pharmacy Workforce Suicide Awareness Day (1–2 posts), and at least 1 post on the day itself.
- Tone Hopeful, supportive, and unifying. Avoid graphic details or triggering language.
- **Engagement** Tag partnering pharmacy organizations, use hashtags, and encourage resharing.
